1) What was your overall opinion of Parable of the Sower?

2) *Parable of the Sower* was written in 1993 and begins during a dystopian 2024. How does Butler's vision of the future compare to what is going on today?

3) In this world, what does a person's survival depend on?

4) How does Lauren's hyperempathy affect her relationships and her choices?

5) In Butler's dystopia, who are the "good guys" and who are the "bad guys"? What does the moral grey area look like?

6) What do you think of the author's choice not to show what happened to Lauren's dad?

7) How do the people that join Lauren's travelling group earn each other's trust?

8) How does Lauren become a leader? How would you describe her leadership?

9) How does Lauren's vision for an Earthseed community differ from the neighborhood where she grew up?

10) What do you think about Lauren's belief that we can change the future by working together towards a common goal? Do you find it too simple?

11) From questioning religion, to depictions of sex, violence, and cannibalism, to a negative portrayal of policing, *Parable of the Sower* contains many themes that could cause it to be banned or challenged. What would you say to someone who wanted to ban this book?

12) *Parable of the Sower* ends during the year 2027. The sequel, *Parable of the Talents*, begins in the year 2032. Would you be interested in continuing the series? Would you find it too depressing to continue?
